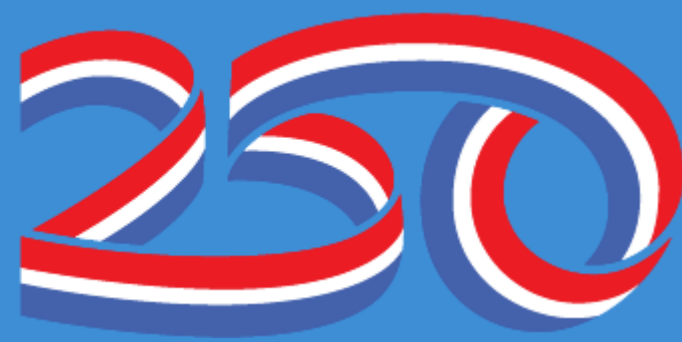

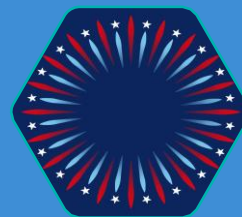
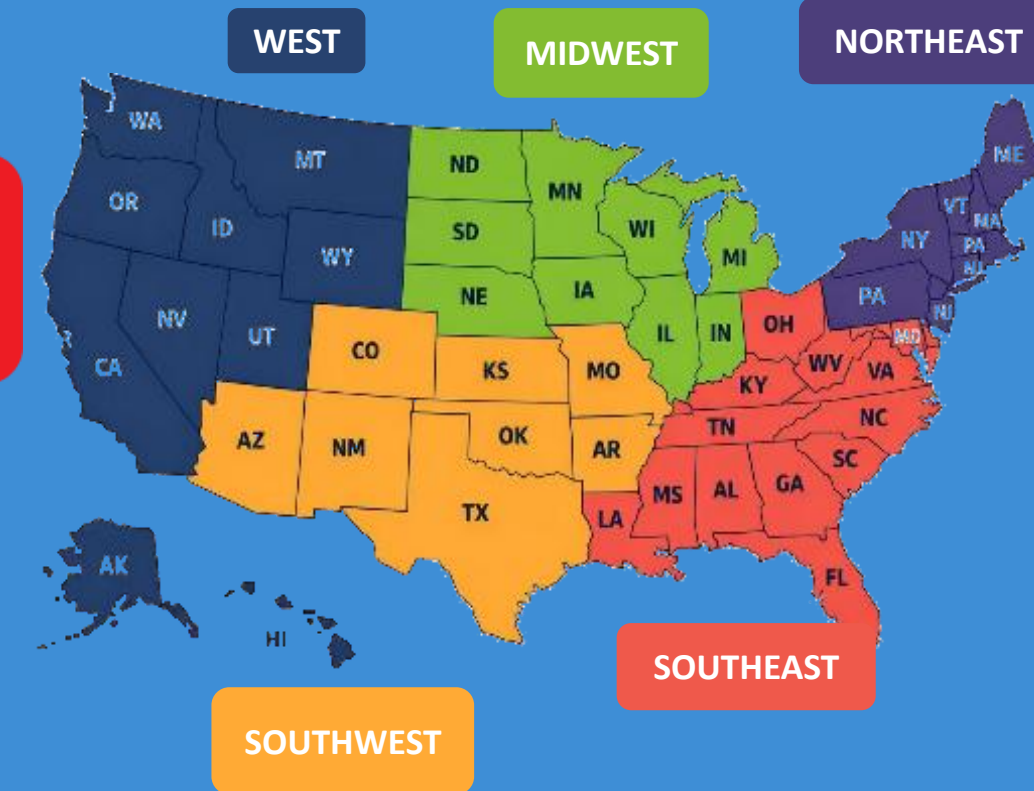

ANSWERS to the Matching Activity: Maple sugar originated with the Ojibwe (Chippewa), Algonquin, Iroquois, and Abenaki nations and primarily was distilled in the Midwest and Northeast. Cornbread originated with the Southeastern Native Americans, including the Cherokee, Choctaw, and Seminole. Venison jerky was popularized with the Cree, Lakota, and Comanche tribes around Southwest and West parts of the U.S. Succotash was cultivated by the Narragansett tribe in the Northeast. Hushpuppies were evolved from Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Creek, and Iroquois. Southeastern and Southwestern tribes popularized this.
